

## **Dario Arrigotti**

Dario Arrigotti graduated in Political Sciences and worked between 1976 and 1996 in the field of international projects and cultural relations at *Fondazione Giovanni Agnelli* in Turin. From 1987 to 1996 he carried out this role as manager at FIAT SpA.

Over this long period of time he worked in publishing, organising research, coordinating international programmes at the foundation itself including conferences and traveling exhibitions in the USA, Argentina, Brazil, Venezuela, Canada, Japan, central Europe etc.

As part of the foundation's foreign activities he coordinated important multimedia publications and exhibitions, which received awards and international recognition.

From 1996 to 2014 he was first manager and then Deputy Director of a UN organisation based in Turin, the International Training Center of the ILO (ITC-ILO), specialised in training leaders from the world over. In this role he was the highest level Italian manager at the International Labour Organisation as well as one of the most senior in the United Nations in Italy. During that period, the ITC-ILO increased its students (people taking part in training) by almost 40% (going from 10,000 to 13,900 a year from 190 countries around the world).

Between 2004 and 2014 the Center Campus owned by the City of Turin was completely renovated and modernised, in both residential and didactic aspects, first in the works carried out for the Winter Olympic Games in Turin 2006 and then thanks to specific projects financed by Regione Piemonte and Compagnia di San Paolo, among others.

From 2011 to December 2014 he was also Director of the *Turin School of Development*, which offers Master programmes and postgraduate courses – in English, French and Spanish – organised by ILO, the University of Turin, by famous foreign universities and by some important UN agencies such as: UNESCO, WIPO, UNCTAD, etc. The Master courses at *Turin School of Development*, attended by approximately 300 students a year from 60 different countries increased from two to eleven.

From December 2014 to May 2016 he was Deputy Chairman of *HYDROAID-Water for Development Management Institute*, based in Turin.

Since February 2015 he has been Advisor to the Mayor of Turin for International Affairs.

Since December 2015 he has been Advisor to the President of Regione Lombardia for International and European Projects.
