

## ALESSANDRO BARBERIS

He was born in 1937 in Turin, where he still lives. He is married with three children.

He graduated in Engineering at Politecnico di Torino.

At the age of 27 he joined Fiat, in the Foundries and Forges Department (Teksid), operating in various areas with increasing responsibilities and becoming Plant Manager of Teksid Mirafiori in 1974.



In 1975 he was put in charge of setting up a large production factory for Fmb (a joint-venture with Minas Gerais) in Belo Horizonte, Brazil, of which he became CEO and general manager. Three years later he became head of the whole Fiat Foundry area, covering 12 productive units and 12,000 employees.

From 1982 to 1993 he was CEO and general manager of Magneti Marelli, initially a company in crisis that he helped build into one of the world's leading groups of automotive components.

In 1993 he was appointed director at Fiat Auto.

In 1996 he left the Fiat Group to become general manager of Istituto Bancario San Paolo di Torino, where he focused in particular on human and technological resources.

From 1997 to 2001 he was chairman of Piaggio & C., Europe's largest motorcycle company, which he restructured, relaunched, and put it into the hands of the new owners

In 2002 he was reappointed to Fiat as general manager of the holding company, of which he was then CEO and finally vice chairman in 2003.

He was president of Industrial Union of Pisa (1998-2001), Confindustria Toscana (1999-2003) and of ANCMA-National Association of manufacturers of motorcycles and accessories (1999-2001). From 1999 he was also Member of Council of Confindustria and from 2002 until 2004 member of the Governing Council of Confindustria.

From June 2008 to May 2013 he was president of InfoCamere.

From January 2010 to December 2013 he was president of Eurochambres.

From July 2004 to September 2014 was president of the Chamber of Commerce for Industry, Handicraft and Agriculture of Turin.

From April 2004 to March 2016 he was a board member of Banca del Piemonte.

From March 2013 to March 2016 he was a board member of Politecnico di Torino.

Since January 2011 he has been member of the General Council of ICC World Chambers Federation.

Since May 2013 he has been vice president of Alliance française de Turin

Since April 2016 he has been member of the General Council of Compagnia di San Paolo.
