

## **Anna Poggi**

Since 2002 she has been Full Professor of Constitutional Law, first at the University of Genoa and currently at the University of Turin, Department of Law.

She has held numerous academic positions, including Dean of the Faculty of Education (2003-2009) and Vice-Rector at the University of Turin with various mandates from 2004 to 2009.

In science and research she has dealt with the judiciary; school and university autonomy; social rights, constitutional and institutional reforms.

She is the author of seven books and 180 publications, curator and co-author of seven volumes, always resulting in ratings over the ANVUR average of scientific productivity.

She has been a speaker at numerous national and international conferences as well as ANVUR evaluator of the products of scientific research.

She has been coordinator of PhDs in Rights and Institutions at the University of Turin (2007-2009) and member of the Governing Board and the Scientific Committee of national and international journals.

From 1<sup>st</sup> November 2009 to 1<sup>st</sup> November 2012 she was a Member of the Executive Council of the Association of Italian Constitutionalists.

As a constitutional expert she was asked to join, among other things, the Ministerial Commission for drafting the Code of Cultural Heritage; the Scientific Committee at ANCI for the implementation of administrative and fiscal decentralization; the so-called "Committee of Wise Men" for drawing up constitutional reform proposals and related electoral legislation.

She has also held numerous institutional charges in education and universities (including: member of the scientific and technical advisory committee on education reform in Italy since 2003, coordinator of the Expert Group of the National Technical Board for the implementation of Title V of Italian constitution about education and vocational training; Chair of the "Fondazione per la Scuola" of the Compagnia di San Paolo; Member of the Technical and Scientific Committee for the implementation of the Quality and Excellence project at the Ministry of Education; Member of the Group of experts for the evaluation of actual general learning outcomes carried out by ANVUR through the TECO test.
