Her career has focused on **4 areas of interest**:

- Urban and local redevelopment projects: since 1998 she has worked on over 50 strategic, local development and integrated urban trade management plans as a consultant for public bodies (Regions, Municipalities) and trade associations. In particular, she helped devise the Lombardy Region's commercial district policy and has worked with regional offices to support the approximately 200 such districts established in the region. She contributed to building an international network of stakeholders interested in the subject and, with the TOCEMA Europe association, designed the European quality certification for commercial districts.
- Town planning and commercial town planning: since 1998 she has completed 40 assignments for municipalities and trade associations in Piedmont.
- Public works projects: from 1998 to 2018 she worked as designer and construction manager on 25 public works projects for municipalities in Piedmont.
- Cultural projects for the enhancement of historical-artistic heritage: from 2014 to date she has carried out various enhancement projects through the use of photography, with a documentary and artistic slant. Her main independent research, entitled *Hospitalia. Or the meaning of care* led to a project exhibited in museums and institutional offices in Italy (Museum of Santa Maria della Scala Siena, Ca' Granda Milan, Galleria San Fedele Milan, Salone Dugentesco Vercelli, etc.) and abroad (Musée de Notre Dame à la Rose Lessines - BE, Musée de la Camargue Arles - FR, etc.) and to the creation of an informal network of around fifty European bodies interested in enhancing healthcare facilities and in transformation projects for decommissioned hospitals. She has an interest in promoting archives on the subject of health and welfare and recently completed a project of re-reading the historical archive of the Monte di Pietà di Bologna, which is held by Fondazione del Monte di Bologna e Ravenna. Her artistic projects have been recognised by awards including the *New Post Photography* - MIA 2020 prize.
