
Programme



Brunate, the funicular and the Volta Lighthouse

Beauty and history overlooking the lake

The village of Brunate dominates the city of Como from its 715-meter altitude. Thanks to its dominant position, it enjoys a splendid view of the lake, but the panorama that can be admired extends over the entire western Alpine arc and for this reason it is also called "the Balcony on the Alps". Between the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century, it became a tourist destination for wealthy Milanese families, who built numerous villas in eclectic or Art Nouveau style.

The Como-Brunate Funicular, which in just a few minutes allows you to overcome the almost 500 meters of altitude difference that separate Brunate from the capital of the Larian region, was inaugurated in 1894.

In Brunate, the Volta Lighthouse also stands out, built in 1927 on the occasion of the centenary of the death of Alessandro Volta, the famous chemist and physicist from Como, inventor of the electric battery. From inside the 29-meter-high octagonal tower, you can reach two spectacular panoramic balconies.




Romano Prodi

is an Italian politician, economist and columnist. President of the European Commission from 1999 to 2004, President of the Council of Ministers of the Italian Republic twice (from 1996 to 1998 and from 2006 to 2008), Romano Prodi is one of the central figures of Italian politics.

Giuseppe Guzzetti

is an Italian lawyer, politician and philanthropist. Former President of the Fondazione Cariplo (from 1997 to 2019) and former President of the Regione Lombardia (from 1979 to 1987), President of ACRI, the association that brings together all the foundations of banking origin in Italy (from 2000 to 2019), Giuseppe Guzzetti is a leading personality in the scene of Italian and international philanthropy.





Teatro Sociale Como

An Italian Theatre from 1813, an educational and cultural center

The Theater, one of the oldest and most astonishing in Northern Italy, was inaugurated in 1813, the year best known to music lovers for the birth of **Richard Wagner** and **Giuseppe Verdi**. The construction work began in 1811 and the project was assigned to the architect Giuseppe Cusi.

The hall, after numerous interventions and restorations, currently has the form of a cello box with 5 orders of seats including: 3 orders, for the 72 privately owned boxes, in addition to the royal box, and 2 orders (4th and 5th) as galleries "loggione". In 1938 the Arena of the Teatro Sociale was transformed into an open-theater, with a structure that hosts up to 4000 people, still used during the Festival Como Città della Musica.

Teatro Sociale is also known as "Piccola Scala", since it hosted the activities of Teatro alla Scala, after the bombing of 1943.

Villa del Balbianello

FAI – Fondo Ambiente Italiano (the National Trust for Italy)

Villa del Balbianello is located on a wooded promontory and is a treasure chest of memories of exploits and adventures on the western shore of Lake Como.

This elegant, romantic 18th century mansion and its magnificent garden have hosted writers, scholars and travelers, including Count Guido Monzino, the last owner of the Villa.

Perched on the edge of the wooded peninsula of Lavedo jutting out over the Lake Como, the Villa offers a wide panorama, which makes it one of the most spectacular estates in the area.

FAI is a non-profit foundation established in 1975, using the National Trust as a model, with the aim of protecting and enhancing Italy's historical, artistic and landscape heritage.






Villa del Grumello

Cultural center and meeting place between culture, education, innovation and creativity

Built in the second half of the 16th century by the Milanese banker Tommaso d'Adda, it became one of the first suburban residences of the Como patriciate on the banks of the Lario, loved for its **enchanting view and privileged position**: surrounded by greenery and at the same time close to the urban core. In 2006, on the initiative of the Como Chamber of Commerce, the Villa del Grumello Association was established, which began the restoration of the Villa in order to give it a new place in the cultural life of the city, as a venue for cultural, entrepreneurial, scientific and of training.

The Villa del Grumello Association is chaired by Dr. Paolo De Santis and is composed of the Como Lecco Chamber of Commerce, ASST lariana – Sant'Anna Hospital and the Alessandro Volta Foundation. It was created with the aim of spreading knowledge, culture and science and promoting the social, educational and economic-entrepreneurial growth of the province of Como.





Gallerie d'Italia – Milan

Masterpieces within masterpieces

Intesa Sanpaolo's Gallerie d'Italia museums are located in the centre of Milan, Naples, Turin and Vicenza. These majestic buildings, which date from between the 17th and 19th centuries and have been meticulously and ambitiously restored before opening to the public, are home to numerous collections and exhibitions. The works of art that lie within these masterpieces of architecture will leave you speechless.

Opened between 2011 and 2012, the Gallerie d'Italia museum of Milan occupies several buildings in Piazza della Scala and offers two marvellous exhibition itineraries: a rich selection of artworks from the 19th century, which also includes collections owned by Fondazione Cariplo, and works from the second half of the 20th century Italy in the Cantiere del '900 section.

In Gallerie d'Italia Milano you can admire numerous masterpieces of art, including 13 plaster bas-reliefs by Antonio Canova and works by Francesco Hayez, Giuseppe Molteni, Alighiero Boetti, Alberto Burri, Lucio Fontana.

It will be possible to visit the Turin painter Felice Carena exhibition, dedicated to one of the most important yet least known artists of the historic 20th century.

A Voice that Dialogues with the Museum


In the beating heart of Milan, within the architectural complex where the Gallerie d'Italia Museum is housed, **VOCE Aimo and Nadia** was born.
